FNR-FAQ-2 Determining Tax Basis of Timber Purdue extension at the time of acquisition This requires knowing the volume present now and the growth rate for the timber The volume present now is the total volume, not just the volume marked for sale Hardwood timber volume typically increases between 2% (poor sites) and 4% (good sites) per year
